- Focus on websites/environments that ITS currently manages



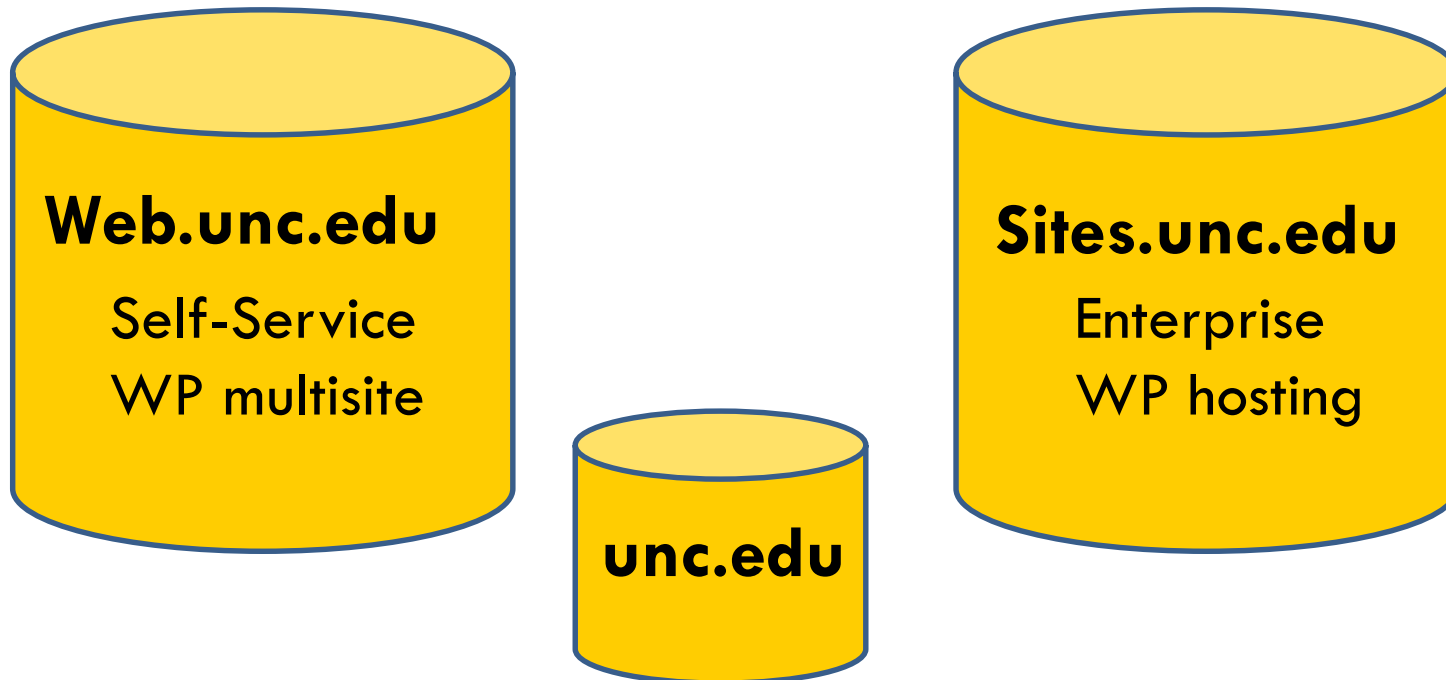

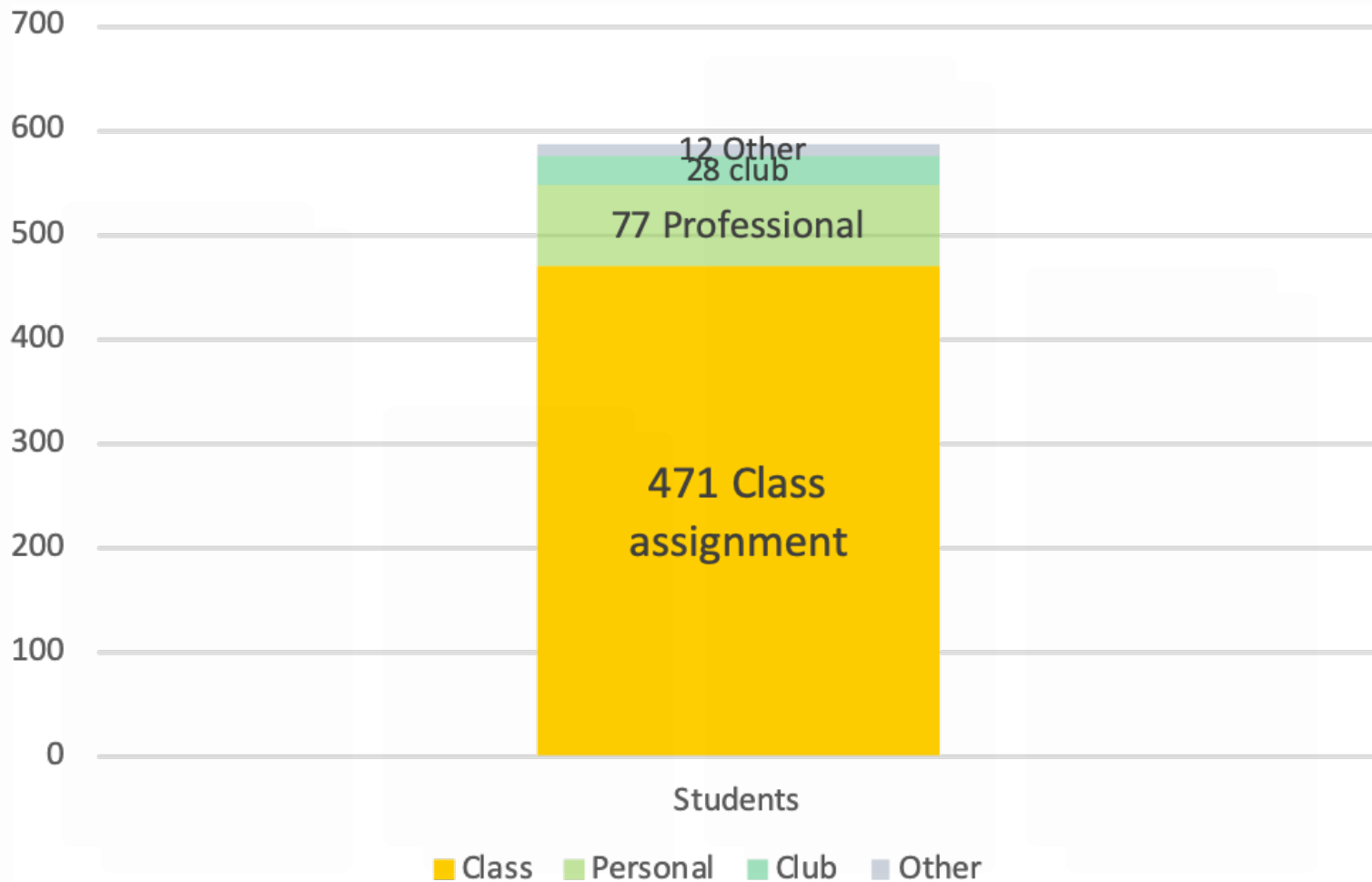


Criteria for a unc.edu domain

Research

Our research examines ways to increase HPV vaccine uptake.

Provider communication

Providers expect HPV vaccine discussions to be lengthy and problematic. We developed the Announcement Approach, for making quick and effective vaccine recommendations. In collaboration with Dr. Melissa Gilkey. Funded by CDC and NCI.

Quality improvement

A quarter of the nation's vaccine providers get quality improvement visits every year. We developed materials to increase the impact of these visits. Led by Dr. Melissa Gilkey in collaboration with state health departments in AZ, NY, WI, WA, MI, and IL. Funded by CDC and RWJF.




